Directions: Read the definition aloud to the participants. Have the participants decide which word best coincides with the definition. Participants should mark the word that matches the definition with a token (button). Once a participant has 5 in a row (diagonal, vertical or horizontal), they should yell “BINGO!” Check the box to the right of the definition to keep track. Have fun!

Term	Definition	✓	✓
Premium	The amount paid for your health insurance or plan, usually paid monthly, quarterly, or annually.		
Deductible	The amount you owe for covered health care services before your health insurance plan begins to pay.		
Copay	A fixed amount you pay for health care services, usually when you get the service.		
Coinsurance	Your share of the costs of a covered health care service, calculated as a percentage.		
Advanced Premium Tax Credit	Part of the ACA, this form of financial assistance reduces the cost of health insurance paid, lowering the monthly premium for plans purchased on the marketplace.		
Provider	Doctor or medical professional.		
PCP-Primary Care Physician	The doctor you see first, usually before you see a specialist.		
Specialist	A health professional or physician that focuses on a specific area of medicine, treatment, diagnosis, management, or prevention.		
In-Network	The facilities, providers and suppliers your health insurer or plan has contracted with to provide health care services.		
Out-of-Network	The facilities, providers and suppliers your health insurer or plan has <b>NOT</b> contracted with to provide health care services.		
Out-of-Pocket Maximum	The most you'll pay for covered services in a policy period, usually a year.		
Marketplace	A place you can learn about your health coverage options. You can compare health insurance plans, benefits and enroll in coverage.		
Medicare	A federal health insurance program for people 65 and older and individuals with disabilities.		
Medicaid	A health insurance program for low-income families and children, pregnant women, the elderly, and people with disabilities.		
CHIP/KidsCare	A health insurance option through AHCCCS for eligible children under the age of 19.		



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Term	Definition	✓	✓
Indian Health Service (IHS)	Responsible for providing federal health services to American Indians and Alaska Natives.		
Explanation of Benefits (EOB)	A health insurance statement explaining the medical treatments and services paid for the insured individual.		
Referral	A written order from your primary care doctor for you to see a specialist or get certain medical services.		
Employer Sponsored Insurance	Health insurance coverage provided by your place of employment.		
Formulary	A list of prescription drugs covered by a plan or another insurance program offering prescription drug benefits.		
Preventive Services	Routine health care that includes screenings, check-ups, and patient counseling to prevent illnesses, disease, or other health problems.		
Private Insurance	Health insurance that is paid by the individual enrolled with a specific health plan via the Marketplace or an insurance provider.		
TRICARE	A health care program for active-duty and retired service members and their families.		
VA Benefits	A health care program for veterans meeting specific eligibility criteria.		
Benefit Coordinator	Serves as a tribal patient advocate for those who need assistance when applying for an alternate resource program, such as Medicare and Medicaid.		
Navigator	A federally trained and certified individual able to help consumers review their health insurance coverage options via the Marketplace, Medicaid and CHIP. Their services are free to consumers.		
Certified Assister	A federally trained and certified individual (like a Navigator or Certified Application Counselor) able to help consumers look for health insurance coverage options. Their services are free to consumers.		
Purchased/ Referred Care (PRC)	A program that IHS and tribal facilities use to purchase services from private health care providers. It is the payer of last resort.
